



Rendezvous 2008 Rules of Sale

Schedule

5:30 Art Preview and Cocktail Reception
7:00 Art Sale Drawing
7:45 Gala Dinner

Artworks will be sold at a Fixed Price set by the artist. Some bronze works are available in multiple editions.

To Purchase an Artwork, print your name on the pre-numbered ballot found in the Ballot Book registered to you at check-in. Remove and place ballot in the numbered box adjacent to the artwork. You may place a ballot in as many different boxes as you wish, but only once per box. The ballot number must match the number on the ballot box.

Art Sale Drawing begins at 7:00 p.m. Ballot boxes are opened. Three names will be drawn. The first name drawn will have 10 minutes to register with an Art Marshal to purchase the piece. If declined, the second name drawn will have 10 minutes to purchase the piece, and so on until the piece is sold.

For bronzes with multiple castings available, several names will be drawn. The first name will receive the bronze that is on display. Subsequent bronzes that are purchased will be shipped from the artist or foundry.

The Art Marshal will hand the purchaser a sales ticket for the artwork. Take this sales ticket to the Sales Desk prior to dinner to make purchase.

Payment

Corporate, business and individual checks, Visa, MasterCard and American Express are all accepted as methods of payment. Thomas Gilcrease Museum Association reserves the right to request identification from any prospective buyer. Payment in full or 50% down plus total sales tax is required. Any remaining balance is due before Monday, July 14, 2008. All checks should be payable to *Thomas Gilcrease Museum Association*.

All artworks purchased during the exhibition will remain on display at Gilcrease Museum through the close of the exhibition on Sunday, July 13, 2008.

All sales are final. All artwork is sold in "AS IS" condition.

State Sales Tax

Thomas Gilcrease Museum Association is required by Oklahoma law to charge sales tax on the sale of any item in the Gilcrease Museum building unless purchased for re-sale. A copy of the purchaser's re-sale tax permit **MUST** be provided at the time of purchase, otherwise sales tax will be collected at the time of purchase.

Pick-Up and Shipping

Purchasers may pick up their artwork between August 11 and August 15, 2008. To make arrangements to pick up purchased artwork, please call the Registrar's office at 918.596.2765. Arrangements for crating, shipping and insurance should be made through The UPS Store at 918.749.2405. Purchaser is required to pay all charges for crating, freight and insurance.

Thomas Gilcrease Museum Association retains 30% from the proceeds of the sale. Consult your accountant for tax deductibility.
